- Pre-ballet Division - Pre-Ballet: 1 hour class for children 5-6 ½ years of age
- Ballet Preparatory: 1 hour class for children 6 ½-7 years of age
- Regular Division - Levels 1 through 7: graded by age and previous experience
- All regular ballet technique classes are 1 ½ hours
- An asterisk (*) next to a class indicates an additional 30 minutes of pointe
- Floorwork & Men’s classes are 1 hour
- Pre-Professional and Artistic Development classes are by invitation only
- Adult Division - Adult Beginner, Adult Intermediate, and Adult Advanced are for adults and teens
- All Adult ballet classes are 1 ½ hours

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The PENNSYLVANIA ACADEMY OF BALLET was established in 1974 to train students who wish to study the art of ballet and who also demand the very best dance training available. All Academy students, regardless of age or professional aspiration, receive the same high quality training whether enrolled in the Regular or the Adult Division.

Academy founders, Margarita and John White, met as members of the Ballet Nacional de Cuba where they performed internationally as Principal and Soloist dancers. They began their extensive teaching careers after learning the Vaganova teaching method from Soviet ballet masters.

After performing internationally herself, Melinda Pendleton, the Whites’ daughter, joined the faculty of the Academy. In 1991, Ms. Pendleton became co-director of the Academy with her parents. She assumed sole directorship of PAB in 2012. Together with their highly trained staff, they teach the Vaganova method of classical ballet. The method emphasizes precise technique, musicality, proper body placement, and a carefully structured breakdown of each movement.

Young children may begin as early as age 3 in our parent participation class, and at age 5 they move to our Pre-ballet division which serves as an introduction to ballet. Academic ballet classes are for children starting at age 8, teens, and adults who attend at least two classes per week. Advanced students take daily classes and also have an opportunity to dance in our performing group.

Students who are interested in a career in classical ballet receive training that provides the technical and artistic skills required to pursue this dream. Many Academy graduates are dancing professionally in ballet companies throughout the world, and several have won high honors in international and national competitions.

We will be offering a hybrid approach to classes this year. Each level will be divided into two groups. Each student will be assigned to either the A Group or the B Group. Their group will determine their in-studio class day. When they are not attending class in-studio, they will be taking class from home via Zoom.

We will be offering grouped Floorwork classes for Levels 1 through 6. All Floorwork classes will be conducted completely online via Zoom, so all Floorwork students will participate from home. Floorwork is a highly beneficial supplemental class that is taken *in addition* to the scheduled technique classes and we strongly recommend (but do not require) that our students participate. If your student chooses to add Floorwork to their schedule, it would increase the 4-week tuition payment by \$60.

ADULT DIVISION CLASSES: Registration for Adult division classes is entirely online through our website www.paacademyofballet.com. The weekly online registration form for Adult classes will become available on the Friday prior and will remain open for the entire week. Students can register class-by-class or for multiple classes within the week. Each class will include an in-studio option for the first 10 students who register and indicate on the registration form that they would like to dance in the studio. Tuition is \$17 per class.
